Oral Presentation Guidelines

- Presentation Structure: Introduction, Material & method, Result & Discussion and Conclusion.
- Ensure slides are clear and not too text-heavy.
- Limit the number of slides (around 10-12).
- Make sure graphs and charts are easy to read and labeled clearly.
- Stick to consistent fonts, sizes and colors for easy readability.
- **❖** Be aware of the allotted time i.e. 8 minutes (Presentation time).

Poster Presentation Guidelines

- **❖** Preferable Poster Size: 3.0 X 2.0 ft. (Landscape).
- ❖ Organize the content in a flow (e.g., Title and Affiliation → Introduction → Methods → Results → Conclusion).
- Use clear, large fonts to ensure readability from a distance.
- Use high-quality images, graphs, and diagrams to illustrate your points.
- **❖** Have a brief 1-2 minute summary ready to explain your research clearly.


