PROCEEDINGS OF EXTENSION EDUCATION COUNCIL MEETING

The Second Extension Education Council Meeting was held in the Vice Chancellor Secretariat, Agriculture University, Jodhpur on **30, August 2017** under the Chairmanship of Dr. Balraj Singh, Hon`ble Vice Chancellor, Agriculture University, Jodhpur.

At the outset, Secretary of the Council and Director Extension, Dr. B.S. Bhimawat, welcomed Hon`ble Vice Chancellor, Dr. Balraj Singh and other members of the council. Thereafter, the Chairman of the Council briefed the members about the progress and major developmental activities going on in the University. The Chairman informed the house that Agriculture University inspite of many constraints is doing excellent work in the sector of Agriculture Technology Development as well as its dissemination to the ultimate users. He also informed the house about two Seed Hub Programmes sanctioned by ICAR to KVK Nagaur and ARS Jalore. He pointed out that Western Rajasthan is growing area of Pomegranate cultivation and alerted that Nematodes attack is going to be major problem in its cultivation. He also suggested its remedial measures.

As per agenda item, Member Secretary, Director Extension Education presented the Annual Progress Report of the Directorate of Extension Education and All the KVKs under its jurisdiction for the year 2016-17. The on & off campus trainings, frontline line demonstrations and sponsored training organized during the season were presented to the members.

The OFTs laid out at farmer's fields, position of R.F. at various KVKs, other developmental activities (purchase of farm implements, repair of shade net and display of agro-techniques through LED display boards etc.) at KVKs were also presented by DEE. The seed production programme undertaken by KVKs was appreciated by Dr. P.N. Kalla, Eminent Scientist and Ex-Director, SKRAU, Bikaner.

DEE presented the training programmes organized under MNOP, NFSM & WDRA. The organization of Pre Kharif and Pre Rabi Sammelans, Celebration of International soil Health day, ICAR foundation day, Kisan Melas, Crop Insurance Mela, GRAM at kota & Jaipur and SAC Meetings conducted by different KVKs were also presented.

The developmental work done by AU, Jodhpur and its entire local components in adopted Smart Village Neora Road was also presented at length by DEE as Nodal Officer of the Village which was appreciated by Dr. P.N. Kalla and Dr. G.N. Mathur Eminent Scientists.

While discussing the future strategies, Secretary Dr. B.S. Bhimawat, DEE briefed the house about the projects sanctioned to Agriculture University, Jodhpur under RKVY and Farmer First Programme by ICAR.

During presenting the report, Secretary informed the house in detail about funds released for development of infra-structure for new KVKs: Phalodi (Jodhpur II), Gudamalani (Barmer II) and Maulasar (Nagaur-II) received in March 2016 and the site for newly allotted additional KVK to Pali District has been identified at Mandala, Sojat and another KVK in district Jalore is in pipeline.

Dr. P.N. Kalla, Eminent Scientist, suggested that revolving fund can be utilized even to develop infra structure at KVKs. He **strongly advocated that vehicle for Director Extension should be purchased from revolving fund at earliest after approval from B.O.M. which was unanimously approved by the house.**

Dr. G.N. Mathur suggested that man power and staffs is essential to achieve the targets. Even help can be taken from corporate sector in form of special developmental projects to meet out this requirement of manpower. He further suggested to popularize Azola through FLDs among the dairy farmers with the assistance of ATMA.

Shri R.S. Shekhawat, Chief Conservator of Forest, invitee member suggested to popularize seven grass among the farmers as it has high nutritive value. Shri Devendra Amrawat, Deputy Registrar Cooperative, suggested different measures to be taken for Rain Water Harvesting and judicious use of water.

Shri Shaila Ram Saharan and Shri Mohan Ram Saharan, Progressive Farmers, appreciated hybrid Bajra variety: MPMH-17 as best variety for Western Rajasthan. Shri C.P. Daga progressive farmer enquired about techniques available for effective control of bird problem in hybrid Bajra Seed Production Programme.

The EEC ended with Vote of Thanks by Dr. S.R. Kumawat, Sr. Scientist & Head, KVK Nagaur.
